

VACANCY: PARISH COUNCILLORS x3

- Do you want to help make decisions for the benefit of your community?
- Can you represent the range of opinions of local people?

If you are over 18 and live or work in the Parish of Cury, which comprises Nantithet, Millewarne, Cross Lanes, Bochym, White Cross and Churchtown, you could be eligible to become a Parish Councillor. The Council is seeking three people to represent the community. Applicants can be from anywhere inside the parish, or outside of the parish and within three miles of the boundary.

Full Council meetings normally take place 6 times a year on the second Monday of every other month at 7pm. You should be able to commit to attend most of the Full Council meetings and have an interest in the local community. You do not need any prior experience of local government. For an informal chat about the vacancy and what the role entails please contact Lee Dunkley, the Clerk. Should you wish to be considered for the role, please write a statement (maximum 300 words) detailing who you are and why you would like to join the Council. This must be received by email to the Clerk by **Saturday 28th February 2026**. You will then be asked to attend the Council meeting on 9th March 2026.
